

DSM 2 Wykład monograficzny: English grammar for translators II

The lecture covers a range of grammatical topics which are significant for translators but are usually not much discussed in standard grammar classes, e.g. atypical English conditionals, nonstandard passives, the middle voice, , unusual gerunds and infinitives, unexpected but useful uses of *any*, *only*, etc. The lecture focuses on the practical significance of such constructions for the translator and complements a set of topics covered in the fall semester but completing the fall part of the lecture is not a prerequisite to enjoying its spring sequel.
